Seeds at Tenbury 2018. Other 2018 festival bookings included The Green Gathering, BOSfest and One Love 2018.

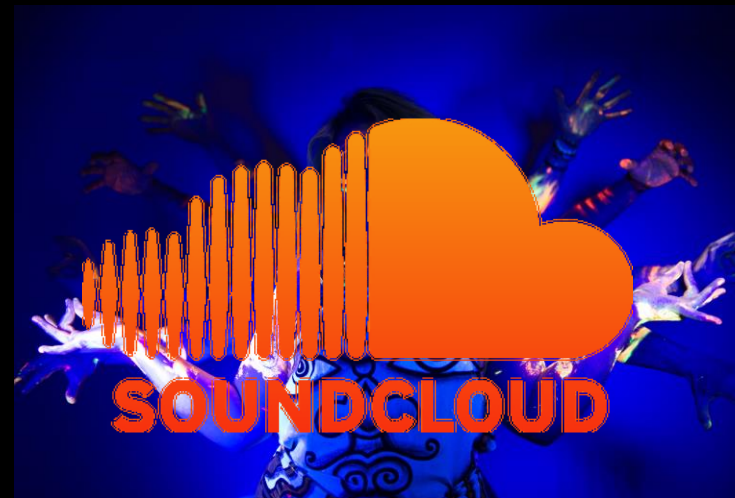

The band currently have two EP's released and are releasing singles on the run up to their debut full album due for release in Spring 2020.

Festivals booked for 2019 have included Noztock, Jurassic Fields, The Green Gathering, Wychwood Festival (invited by BBC), Minety Festival and others as well as continuing to perform at venues throughout the UK. The band have a Germany tour planned for 2020 and already have 2020 festivals and European venues booked.
